HB 2020

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/7/25 MEETING: Requires that qualified nonprofit agencies for individuals with disabilities employ individuals with disabilities for not less than 50 percent of the work hours of direct labor required for manufacturing or providing products or services.

HB 2236

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/7/25 MEETING: Directs the Director of the Employment Department to reimburse a worker leasing company for any employer contribution payments made by the worker leasing company if the Department of Revenue determines pursuant to an amended combined quarterly report that a refund is due.

HB 2425

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/7/25 MEETING: Requires public bodies that procure electric vehicles and solar photovoltaic energy systems to receive before entering a contract for the electric vehicle or solar photovoltaic energy system a certification from the manufacturer, distributor, vendor or supplier that the production, assembly, transportation or sale of the electric vehicle or solar photovoltaic energy system did not use or involve forced labor or oppressive child labor.

HB 3363 **

HB 3838

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/7/25 MEETING: Establishes the Home and Community-Based Services Workforce Standards Board.

HB 3881

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 4/7/25 MEETING: Adds school districts, education service districts and public charter schools to the definition of "qualifying agency" for the purpose of applying apprenticeship requirements in connection with constructing public improvement projects.
