Sunset Review of Property Tax Exemptions - HBs 2074, 2077 and 2078

Public Hearing

HB 2074

Extends the sunset date for the partial property tax exemption for the property of vertical housing development projects.

HB 2077

Extends the sunset date for the property tax exemption for nonprofit corporation low income housing.

HB 2078

Extends the sunset date for the property tax exemption for multiunit rental housing.

HB 2072

Extends certain taxes on the privilege of harvesting merchantable forest products on forestlands.

HB 2083 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires the Legislative Revenue Officer to study the feasibility and utility of enacting a single statute that uniformly governs adjustments for inflation in the tax statutes of this state.
