Work Session

- HB 3589 A** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Requires the Housing and Community Services Department to develop a senior housing development initiative.
- HB 3506 A** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Transfers moneys from the Senior Property Tax Deferral Revolving Account to the Healthy Homes Repair Fund for the purpose of supporting seniors and individuals with disabilities.
- HB 3712
Changes the metrics for a homestead's real market value and the household income of a claimant in order to expand eligibility for the homestead property tax deferral program.

Public Hearing

- HB 3236 A
Expands purposes for the corporate excise tax credit allowed for affordable housing lending.
- HB 2732
Increases, for purposes of tax credit allowed for crop donation, percentage of wholesale price allowed as amount of credit.
- HB 3380
Increases the tax credit allowed to rural volunteer emergency medical services providers from \$250 per tax year to \$1,000 per tax year.
- SB 101
Extends the date by which an account holder must open a first-time home buyer savings account in order to claim a subtraction for contributed funds or an exemption for earnings.
