SB 110 A

Increases the amount of incremental baseball tax revenues that the Oregon Department of Administrative Services may grant for the purpose of constructing a major league baseball stadium.

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Adds "nicotine derived from any source" to the definitions of "inhalant delivery system" and "tobacco products."

HB 2072

Extends certain taxes on the privilege of harvesting merchantable forest products on forestlands.

SB 546

Allows the Department of Revenue to establish electronic means for the collection of elector signatures in support of inclusion of an entity on a schedule of the income tax return for the purpose of receiving contributions by means of checkoff.

HB 3049

Modifies provisions governing a corporate excise tax exemption allowed for business firms operating in certain economically lagging areas.

HB 2082 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires the Legislative Revenue Officer to study the funding of the assessment and taxation functions of the property tax system in Oregon.
