HB 2870 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Creates the Oregon Campaign Review Commission to investigate complaints of false statements made by candidates or political committees.

HB 3954

Prohibits the Adjutant General for assisting or allowing the United States Department of Defense or any branch thereof to communicate with any individual or unit of the Oregon National Guard for purposes of calling the individual or unit into active service unless the active service is for a certain listed reason.

HB 3968

Adds Space Force to the components of the Armed Forces of the United States.

SCR 18

Recognizes and honors John McArdle for his leadership and service to the City of Independence and the State of Oregon.

SCR 25

Recognizes and honors Ruth McEwen for her outstanding service to the people of the State of Oregon.

HCR 37

SCR 23

Creates a ceremonial relationship between the State of Oregon and Cherkasy Oblast, Ukraine.

HB 3569

Requires an agency that appoints a rules advisory committee with regard to rules implementing legislation to invite the first chief sponsor to participate on the committee as a nonvoting member.
