HB 2454 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Authorizes the Joint Legislative Audit Committee to appoint a Legislative Audit Officer and to direct the officer to perform specified duties, including investigating, reviewing activities of and oversight of executive branch agencies, taking in and investigating complaints of members of the public concerning executive branch agency programs, conducting performance audits of executive branch agencies and reporting to the committee on work undertaken by the officer.

HB 3582

Eliminates the statute of limitations for civil actions based on sexual assault or child sexual abuse.

HB 3881

Adds school districts, education service districts and public charter schools to the definition of "qualifying agency" for the purpose of applying apprenticeship requirements in connection with constructing public improvement projects.

HB 3953

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/19/2025 MEETING: Allows an applicant for a public charter school that is a federally recognized Indian tribe in this state to directly apply to the State Board of Education for sponsorship.
