Possible Introduction of Committee Measures

SB 789

Authorizes the Oregon Board of Psychology to assess costs associated with disciplinary action to the person against whom the disciplinary action is taken.

SB 1039

Creates the Oregon Perinatal Collaborative in the Oregon Health and Science University.

SB 1099

Requires cities and counties to allow lands where worship is allowed to be used for preschool.

Public Hearing

SB 1167

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to seven entities to support the development of successful children in this state.

SB 142

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study the progress of and investment opportunities in specified programs.
