SB 420 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys to the Department of Early Learning and Care out of the General Fund to expand or sustain Healthy Families Oregon home visiting services.

SB 527 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Oregon Health Authority to develop and implement a grant program to distribute moneys to local workforce development boards to partner with certain entities to provide behavioral health education and training for high school students.

SB 1033

Exempts a county that operates a nurse-family partnership program from paying the nonfederal share of the costs of targeted case management services provided by the program to medical assistance recipients.

Note change: SB 1013 has been removed. SB 527 has been added.
