Directs the Oregon Health Authority to conduct studies and adopt rules relating to residential treatment facilities, residential treatment homes, secure residential treatment facilities and secure residential treatment homes.

Directs the Oregon Health Authority to develop and implement a grant program to distribute moneys to local workforce development boards to partner with certain entities to provide behavioral health education and training for high school students.

SB 920

Directs the Oregon State University Extension Service to oversee a project to accelerate the promotion of behavioral health in Oregon.

1013 ** SB

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Appropriates moneys to the Department of Justice out of the General Fund for distribution to the Liberty House to provide children's advocacy center services.

SB 1167

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to seven entities to support the development of successful children in this state.
