SB 62 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to develop, implement and administer a program to support consumer engagement efforts aimed at increasing and optimizing consumer involvement in planning and decision-making surrounding the access to, and delivery of, behavioral health services in this state.

SB 142

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study the progress of and investment opportunities in specified programs.

SB 527 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

- CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03-25-2025 AGENDA: Directs the Oregon Health Authority to develop and implement a grant program to distribute moneys to local workforce development boards to partner with certain entities to provide behavioral health education and training for high school students.
- SB 567 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Directs the Department of Early Learning and Care to establish and implement a child care provider incentive program.
