SB 62 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to develop, implement and administer a program to support consumer engagement efforts aimed at increasing and optimizing consumer involvement in planning and decision-making surrounding the access to, and delivery of, behavioral health services in this state.

SB 142

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study the progress of and investment opportunities in specified programs.

SB 527 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Oregon Health Authority to develop and implement a grant program to distribute moneys to local workforce development boards to partner with certain entities to provide behavioral health education and training for high school students.

SB 702

Prohibits distributing, selling, attempting to sell or offering to sell flavored inhalant delivery system products or flavored tobacco products in this state.

SB 1167

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to seven entities to support the development of successful children in this state.

SB 1195

Directs the Oregon Health Authority to conduct studies and adopt rules relating to residential treatment facilities, residential treatment homes, secure residential treatment facilities and secure residential treatment homes.
