Work Session

- SB 527 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs the Oregon Health Authority to develop and implement a grant program to distribute moneys to local workforce development boards to partner with certain entities to provide behavioral health education and training for high school students.
- SB 691 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs the Oregon Health Authority to distribute moneys to an entity within the Oregon Health and Science University that advocates for improved maternal and neonatal outcomes.
- SB 693 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Establishes the Task Force on the Perinatal Workforce.
- SB 695 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs the Oregon Health Authority, for contracts entered into between the authority and a coordinated care organization, to establish terms and conditions designed to achieve transformational changes to maternal and infant health.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 690
Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study perinatal public health issues.

Note change: SB 692 and SB 702 have been removed.
