SB 527 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Directs the Oregon Health Authority to develop and implement a grant program to distribute moneys to local workforce development boards to partner with certain entities to provide behavioral health education and training for high school students.

- SB 691 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Directs the Oregon Health Authority to distribute moneys to an entity within the Oregon Health and Science University that advocates for improved maternal and neonatal outcomes.
- SB 692 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Establishes a community-based perinatal provider access program to increase access to culturally specific perinatal services and culturally competent perinatal services providers.
- SB 693 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Establishes the Task Force on the Perinatal Workforce

Establishes the Task Force on the Perinatal Workforce. SB 695 **

695 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Directs the Oregon Health Authority, for contracts entered into between the authority and a coordinated care organization, to establish terms and conditions designed to achieve transformational changes to maternal and infant health.

SB 702

Prohibits distributing, selling, attempting to sell or offering to sell flavored inhalant delivery system products or flavored tobacco products in this state.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 690

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study perinatal public health issues.
