SB 690

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04-03-2025 AGENDA: Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study perinatal public health issues.

SB 692 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Establishes a community-based perinatal provider access program to increase access to culturally specific perinatal services and culturally competent perinatal services providers.

SB 702

Prohibits distributing, selling, attempting to sell or offering to sell flavored inhalant delivery system products or flavored tobacco products in this state.

SB 1195

Directs the Oregon Health Authority to conduct studies and adopt rules relating to residential treatment facilities, residential treatment homes, secure residential treatment facilities and secure residential treatment homes.
