Public Hearing

HB 2741

Directs the Oregon Health Authority to maintain a state public health laboratory, administer a newborn bloodspot screening program and implement additional programs related to newborn bloodspot screening.

HB 2901

Modifies the safe haven law to allow a parent to anonymously leave an infant in a newborn safety device.

HB 3195 A

Modifies eligibility requirements for distributions from the Children's Advocacy Center One-Time Grant Fund.
