#### **Public Hearing**

SB 979 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct a study on ensuring post-secondary educational opportunities for individuals with disabilities.

SB 981

Increases the maximum age under which a student may receive a public education.

SB 982

Authorizes school districts to use public funds for out-of-state placement of students only if specified criteria are satisfied.

Revises the duties of boards of education of community college districts.

Requires school district boards to ensure all schools offer computer science education in all grades.

SB 720 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to the Portland Opportunities Industrialization Center to construct and operate the Sunrise Campus Cultural Workforce Center.

SB 768 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Requires the State of Oregon to contribute a 50 percent match for every donation of \$10,000 or more made to the Oregon State University Foundation for the express purpose of supporting agricultural research with emphasis on cereal grains, to the extent moneys are available.

SB 933

Requires school districts to submit specified information to the Department of Education related to talented and gifted children.

SB 934

Prescribes requirements for the identification of talented and gifted children.

# AGENDA (cont.) March 5, 2025

SB 948

Authorizes district school boards to provide for play-based learning during the instructional time of each regular school day for all students who are enrolled in prekindergarten through grade five in the school district.
