Public Hearing

SB 390

Prohibits the Higher Education Coordinating Commission from making any distributions during the 2025-2027 biennium to the University of Oregon unless the University of Oregon transfers to the commission for distribution to Oregon State University the balance of any receipts received by the University of Oregon from the athletic conference of which the university is a member.

SB 396

Requires public universities to establish a common application for undergraduate admission.

SB 401 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Increases the weight allotted for children in poverty for purposes of State School Fund distributions.

SB 980 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to study and develop a list of standardized job profiles for unlicensed school jobs.

Work Session

SB 324

Transfers certain duties, functions and powers related to teaching, administrative and personnel licensure from the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to the Department of Education.

SB 979 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct a study on ensuring post-secondary educational opportunities for individuals with disabilities.

SB 981

Increases the maximum age under which a student may receive a public education.

SB 982

Authorizes school districts to use public funds for out-of-state placement of students only if specified criteria are satisfied.
