#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 302

Requires the Department of Education to study the adequacy of public education in this state for kindergarten through grade 12.

SB 306

Requires the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to study higher education.

SB 544

Requires vaporizing detection devices to be installed in certain areas of high schools that have 1,000 or more enrolled students.

SB 581 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Creates the psychology provider incentive program within the Oregon Health Authority to provide financial incentives to students enrolled in approved doctoral programs in psychology who complete courses that provide cultural competency training.

SB 1157

Requires the Department of Education to study methods for improving safety in the public schools of this state.

SB 1193

Permits a post-secondary institution of education to provide compensation to a student athlete for use of the student athlete's name, image, likeness or athletic reputation.

#### Work Session

SB 141

Requires the Department of Education to study methods for increasing the accountability of the public education system of this state.

SB 981

Increases the maximum age under which a student may receive a public education.
