HB 2421 A

Includescertain private post-secondary institutions in the direct admissions program established by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission.

HB 3041

Modifies the source of law that establishes the Educator Advancement Council from intergovernmental agreement to state statute.

HB 3063

Provides that a student who is in a hospital educational program shall continue to remain enrolled in the school district in which the student had been a resident prior to being in the hospital educational program only for the purpose of maintaining access to classroom curricula and associated technology.

HB 3083 A

Directs the governing body of a school to consider the installation of a panic alarm system as part of the policies and procedures relating to school building security.
