HB 2251 A

Directs school districts to adopt a policy that prohibits the use of student personal electronic devices.

HB 2453 A

Removes the requirement that an educational equity advisory committee must advise a school district board.

HB 2514 A

Permits an education service district to contract bonded indebtedness for capital costs in excess of limits applicable to component school districts.

HB 2596

Enacts the School Psychologist Interstate Licensure Compact.

HB 2670 A

Broadens the description of what constitutes abrain injury for determining when a child is considered a child with a disability for purposes of qualifying for special education.

HB 2684 A

Requires that a school integrated pest management plan be reviewed at least once every five years and made available to the public on a website.

HB 2900 A

Modifies the definition of "contract teacher" for the purposes of the Accountability for Schools for the 21st Century Law.

HB 3007 A

Prescribes the requirements for an immediate and temporary accommodations plan to be implemented when a public education provider receives notification that a student has been diagnosed with a concussion or other brain injury.

HB 3026 A

Modifies eligibility requirements for a scholarship program for teacher candidates.

HB 3038 A

Adjusts purposes and eligible recipients of grants related to STEM education.

HB 3365 A

Directs the State Board of Education toensure that academic content standards for core subjects include sufficient instruction on the causes and effects of climate change and strategies for responding to such causes and effects.

HB 3731 A

Provides additional data to be included by institutions of higher education in an annual report regarding allegations of sexual misconduct and violence on the campus of the institution.
