SB 221

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 3/17/2025 MEETING: Directs the State Department of Fish and Wildlife to study the salmon and trout enhancement program.

Possible Work Session

SB 222 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the State Department of Fish and Wildlife to operate a program in southwest Oregon to control populations of species that prey on salmon.

SB 339 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the State Forestry Department for purposes related to the plant disease Sudden Oak Death.

The following work session on Senate Bill 88 is scheduled solely for the purpose of committee discussion.

SB 88 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Judiciary

Prohibits an electric or gas company from recovering from ratepayers costs or expenses associated with advertising, political influence activity, litigation, penalties or fines and certain compensation.

Public Hearing

SB 1047

Requires the Oregon Business Development Department to study access to resources for development in Curry County and submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to natural resources no later than September 15, 2026.

SB 1143 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Public Utility Commission to establish a pilot program that allows each natural gas company to develop a utility-scale thermal energy network pilot project to provide heating and cooling services to customers.
