Possible Work Session

SB 577

Requires an electric utility to recover costs for storing the waste produced by an energy facility in generating electricity.

SB 956

Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to provide a grant to Heard Farms to expand wastewater treatment infrastructure.

SB 1034

Removes provisions that allow the Energy Facility Siting Council to find that an energy facility is in compliance with statewide planning goals even when the council determines that the facility does not comply with applicable substantive criteria from the affected local government's land use plan and regulations that the facility must be evaluated against if the council determines that the facility otherwise complies with applicable statewide planning goals.

SB 1067

Authorizes a city within Marion County to control or direct the disposal, transfer or material or energy recovery of solid waste generated within the city.

Public Hearing

SB 1187

Establishes the Climate Superfund Cost Recovery Program as an interagency response to the effects of climate change.
