111 \*\* SB

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures

Extends the sunsets for the pass-through business alternative income tax and the related personal income tax credit.

SB382

> Exempts receipts from the sale of prescription drugs by all licensed retail pharmacies from commercial activity subject to the corporate activity tax.

Expands the exemption for receipts from the sale of prescription drugs from commercial activity subject to the corporate activity tax to include critical access pharmacies.

#### **Work Session**

SB 101

Extends the date by which an account holder must open a first-time home buyer savings account in order to claim a subtraction for contributed funds or an exemption for earnings.

SB102

> Provides that a court may not stay or prohibit a Federal Home Loan Bank from exercising rights to collateral pledged by an insurer-member that is subject to a delinquency proceeding.
