Work Session

- SB 108 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures
Extends the sunset for the income and corporate excise tax credit for crop donation.
- SB 112 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures
Extends the sunset for the tax credit for pension income.
- SB 121 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures
Extends the sunset for the earned income tax credit.
- SB 122 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Tax Expenditures
Extends the sunset for the tax credit for closure of a manufactured dwelling park.

Public Hearing and Work Session

- SB 120
Requires the Legislative Revenue Officer to study tax expenditures.

Public Hearing

- SB 1205
Extends the sunset for the personal income tax subtraction for amounts received in resolution of a civil action arising from wildfire.
- SB 1134
Creates an Oregon personal income tax subtraction for premiums paid for medical, dental or vision insurance coverage for a child dependent of the taxpayer.
