SB 813

Adds employees of the Oregon Youth Authority or a county juvenile department to the list of people who are authorized to petition the circuit court for an order compelling a third party to complete a test for communicable diseases under certain circumstances.

SB 846

Modifies the requirements for how the Oregon Health Authority monitors the progress of coordinated care organizations in improving access to and the quality of health care for children and youth in the areas served by the coordinated care organizations.

Public Hearing

SB 597 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Oregon Health Authority to establish a grant program to provide financial support to certified dental sealant programs that promote and engage in oral health care coordination activities.

822 ** SB

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Expands network adequacy requirements to health benefit plans offered to large employers and modifies requirements.

SB 837 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Modifies laws governing the emergency health care provider registry to allow a broader range of volunteer services and allow deployment of volunteers outside of declared emergencies.

SB 943

Changes the definitions of "audiologist" and "practice of audiology.
