- SB 529 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs the Oregon Health Authority and coordinated care organizations to contract directly with traditional health workers, community health registered nurses and community-based organizations to provide services to medical assistance recipients.
- SB 533  
Creates a civil penalty for drug manufacturers that interfere directly or indirectly with certain entities acquiring 340B drugs, delivering 340B drugs to certain health care providers or dispensing 340B drugs.
- SB 549  
Prohibits the Oregon Health Authority and coordinated care organizations from requiring prior authorization for the repair of complex rehabilitation technology.
- SB 699  
Expands the health insurance coverage of prosthetic and orthotic devices.
- SB 528 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Appropriates moneys to be used for regional health equity coalitions.
- SB 530 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires the Oregon Health Authority to adjust for inflation the amount of any grant awarded to a regional health equity coalition.

#### Public Hearing

- SB 293  
Requires the Department of Corrections to study health care for adults in custody.
- SB 295  
Authorizes a pharmacist to assess, diagnose and treat certain health conditions.
- SB 1161 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs the Oregon Health Authority to issue licenses to enable a person to drive an organ transport vehicle.
