Work Session

529 ** SB

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Oregon Health Authority and coordinated care organizations to contract directly with traditional health workers, community health registered nurses and community-based organizations to provide services to medical assistance recipients.

SB 533

Creates a civil penalty for drug manufacturers that interfere directly or indirectly with certain entities acquiring 340B drugs, delivering 340B drugs to certain health care providers or dispensing 340B drugs.

SB 549

Prohibits the Oregon Health Authority and coordinated care organizations from requiring prior authorization for the repair of complex rehabilitation technology.

 - Expands the health insurance coverage of prosthetic and orthotic devices.
- 528 ** SB **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Appropriates moneys to be used for regional health equity coalitions.

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Requires the Oregon Health Authority to adjust for inflation the amount of any grant awarded to a regional health equity coalition.

Public Hearing

SB 293

Requires the Department of Corrections to study health care for adults in custody.

SB 295

Authorizes a pharmacist to assess, diagnose and treat certain health conditions.

SB 1161 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Directs the Oregon Health Authority to issue licenses to enable a person to drive an organ transport vehicle.

SB 42

Requires the Oregon Health Authority to study vaccine financing.

Work Session

SB 951

Prohibits a management services organization, an individual who works as an independent contractor with a management services organization or a shareholder, director, officer or employee of a management services organization from owning or controlling shares in, serving as a director or officer of, being an employee of, working as an independent contractor with or otherwise managing, directing the management of or participating in managing a professional medical entity with which the management services organization has a contract for management services.
