Public Hearing

SB 586

Reduces from 90 to 45 days the termination notice period that a landlord must give the tenant when selling the dwelling unit to buyers who intend to reside in the unit.

SB 1095

Authorizes cities and counties to impose a fee on noncommercial residences that are vacant for more than 180 consecutive or cumulative days in a calendar year.

SB 973

Requires a landlord of publicly supported housing to provide all applicants and new tenants notice of when the affordability restrictions may be terminated.

SB 31

Requires the Housing and Community Services Department to study housing.

SB 32

Requires the Housing and Community Services Department to study housing.

Note change: SB 586 and 1095 added.
