HB 2658

Prohibits cities or counties from conditioning a permit or zoning change on the development of an improvement project that has already been financed, planned or approved.

HB 3136 A

Removes a requirement that a maximum of two real estate professionals may serve on a city or county planning commission for commissions with more than five members.

HB 3545 A

Establishes when homeowners and condominium association assessments accrue on property deeded to the county in the tax foreclosure process.

HB 2964 A

Requires the Housing and Community Services Department to award loans for the predevelopment costs of affordable housing.
