#### Public Hearing

SB 422 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Directs the Department of Human Services to implement a pilot stabilization program to reduce disruptions in placement and identify long-term solutions to better serve individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities, including individuals who experience co-occurring diagnoses.

SB 909  
Directs the Oregon Health Authority to provide flexible and innovative home and community-based services and supports through the medical assistance program to children and youth that have a serious emotional disturbance.

#### Work Session

SB 136  
Authorizes the Department of Human Services to revoke a license, certificate or endorsement of a provider of community-based services to individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities if the department deems the provider unqualified.

SB 794  
Modifies provisions regarding Oregon Public Guardian and Conservator duties and powers to provide services and supports to certain persons.
