Public Hearing

SB 1065

Establishes the Center for Decision-Making Supports.

SB 1066

Makes permanent an exception for certain residential training homes and adult foster homes from state building code requirements to have installed an automatic sprinkler system.

SB 1063

Requires the Department of Human Services to study options for establishing a grant program for victims of child sex abuse.

SB 34

Requires the Department of Human Services to study long term care.

SB 135

Requires the appointment of court appointed special advocates to specified advisory councils, advisory committees and review teams.

SB 915

Directs the Director of Human Services to ensure that standards and procedures for the assessment and investigation of reports of child abuse committed by certain persons are investigated by a department program that specializes in training, investigations and safety.

Youth Voices

Any current or former youth with experience receiving child welfare services is invited to submit written or verbal testimony to the Committee at this time on any topic they choose. Those who choose to participate may submit written testimony rather than verbal, and written comments will be included in the public record.
