### Work Session

SB 1066

Makes permanent an exception for certain residential training homes and adult foster homes from state building code requirements to have installed an automatic sprinkler system.

SB 228

Establishes the right of a resident of a residential care facility to the formation of a family council.

SB 944

Modifies independent living requirements for older foster children.

SB 1065

Establishes the Center for Decision-Making Supports.

SB 736

Creates an exception to abuse of a child in care provisions when the suspected abuse was committed by the parent of the child in care.

SB 915

Directs the Director of Human Services to ensure that standards and procedures for the assessment and investigation of reports of child abuse committed by certain persons are investigated by a department program that specializes in training, investigations and safety.

SB 730

Modifies provisions regarding subsidies for adoptive parents and guardians.

SB 1159

Transfers the office of Children's Advocate from the Department of Human Services to the office of the Long Term Care Ombudsman.
