#### Work Session

- SB 20 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Requires the Department of Human Services to administer a program to provide medical assistance to employed individuals with disabilities without regard to the individuals' income or resources.
- SB 909  
Directs the Oregon Health Authority to provide flexible and innovative home and community-based services and supports through the medical assistance program to children and youth that have a serious emotional disturbance.
- SB 228  
Establishes the right of a resident of a residential care facility to the formation of a family council.
- SB 736  
Creates an exception to abuse of a child in care provisions when the suspected abuse was committed by the parent of the child in care.

#### Public Hearing

- SB 1113  
Modifies provisions regarding the use of restraints and involuntary seclusion on certain young people.
- SB 132  
Requires the Department of Human Services to study the demographics of children in Oregon.
- SB 133  
Requires the Department of Human Services to study developmental disabilities services.
