Public Hearing

SB 468

Provides that a noncompetition agreement is void and unenforceable if entered into with an employee who is a health professional.

SB 957

Voids noncompetition agreements between a licensed health care provider and another person, with specified exceptions.

SB 665

Requires public bodies to transfer moneys deriving from certain fines and civil penalties to the General Fund for general governmental purposes.

SB 832

Makes certain changes related to civil penalties for violations related to disease control.

SB 18

Increases the criminal and civil penalties for subsequent and intentional violations of specified election laws.

SB 98

Modifies provisions relating to court processes and procedures.
