#### Public Hearing

- SB 162 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means  
Authorizes the destruction of hoop houses when executing a search warrant to investigate the unlawful production of marijuana.
- SB 556  
Allows a marijuana producer, marijuana wholesaler, marijuana processor or marijuana retailer to use a motion detection camera system at a licensed premises.
- SB 557  
Requires at least one of the commissioners of the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission to hold a marijuana processor, marijuana producer, marijuana retailer or marijuana wholesaler license.
- SB 558  
Allows a marijuana licensee to provide samples of marijuana items to other marijuana licensees at temporary events registered with the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission.
- SB 870  
Exempts from public records disclosure the residential address and personal phone number of an individual who holds a specified permit issued by the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission.

#### Work Session

- Possible Introduction of Committee Measures
- SB 300  
Modifies the definition of "private security entity" for purposes of private security requirements.
- SB 890  
Disestablishes the subcommittee on public records and changes the committee that reviews the Oregon Sunshine Committee reports to the committees or interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary.
