Public Hearing

SB 170

Requires the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study workplace assault convictions and sentences.

SB 389

Allows a person to petition for an order restraining a respondent from harassment of the petitioner.

SB 804

Authorizes the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission to impose civil penalties or order payment of the costs of disciplinary proceedings.

SB 872

Modifies laws related to the State Mortuary and Cemetery Board's authority to impose disciplinary actions on applicants and those subject to the board's regulatory authority.

SB 723
