#### **Public Hearing**

SB 1091

Defines what a transportation protection agreement for human remains is.

SB 1191

Provides that certain laws establishing crimes do not apply to the act of informing another person of the other person's civil or constitutional rights.

#### Work Session

SB 65

Allows a person who has been deprived of rights, privileges or immunities secured by the Oregon Constitution or the laws of this state by a person acting under color of law to bring a civil action for economic and noneconomic damages and for injunctive or other equitable relief.

SB 174

Provides that a violation of prohibitions against certain practices with respect to insurance is subject to an enforcement action under the Unlawful Trade Practices Act.

SB 233

Extends the statute of ultimate repose for claims for certain injuries from health care to 10 years from the date of the treatment, omission or operation upon which the action is based.

SB 872

Modifies laws related to the State Mortuary and Cemetery Board's authority to impose disciplinary actions on applicants and those subject to the board's regulatory authority.
