#### Public Hearing

HB 2008 A

Prohibits controllers from processing personal data for the purposes of targeted advertising, or selling personal data that pertains to a consumer, if the controller has actual knowledge, or disregards knowledge of whether, a consumer is under 16 years of age or if the personal data accurately identifies within a radius of 1,750 feet a consumer's present or past location or the present or past location of a device that links or is linkable to the consumer.

HB 3426 A

Expands offenses relating to the use of an unmanned aircraft system to interfere with official duties to include firefighting and search and rescue efforts.

#### Work Session

HB 2299 A

Modifies the crime of unlawful dissemination of an intimate image to include the disclosure of digitally created, manipulated or altered images.

HB 2460 A

Updates, reorganizes and modifies the provisions governing appeals from justice courts that have not become courts of record.

HB 2471 A

Modifies when a person is guilty except for insanity.

HB 2632 A

Directs the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court to appoint an advisory committee on treatment courts.

HB 3174 A

Increases the fee paid for alcohol and drug screening specialists.

HB 3604 A

Establishes a defense to prosecution for theft, and immunity from civil liability, for an entity that takes possession of, keeps or disposes of a cat as provided in the Act.

**Note change: HB 2119 A and HB 2522 removed.**
