Public Hearing

HB 2614 A

Directs the Oregon Public Defense Commission to submit an agency request budget to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services after approval by commission members.

Work Session

HB 2008 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/12 MEETING: Prohibits controllers from processing personal data for the purposes of targeted advertising, or selling personal data that pertains to a consumer, if the controller has actual knowledge, or disregards knowledge of whether, a consumer is under 16 years of age or if the personal data accurately identifies within a radius of 1,750 feet a consumer's present or past location or the present or past location of a device that links or is linkable to the consumer.

HB 3174 A

Increases the fee paid for alcohol and drug screening specialists.

HB 3825 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5/12 MEETING: Provides that judgment remedies for judgments of conviction in municipal and justice courts for the possession of less than one ounce of marijuana expire on the effective date of the Act.

HB 3865 A

Prohibits as an unlawful practice under the Unlawful Trade Practices Act a person's initiating a telephone solicitation outside specified hours or more than three separate times within a 24-hour period, misrepresenting or falsifying the person's identity, the purpose of the call or the location from which the person is calling or failing to make required disclosures or inquiries during the call.

HB 3929 A

Modifies provisions related to the confidentiality and admissibility of communications by certain public safety employees to a peer supporter.

Note change: HB 2008 A and HB 3825 A added.
