#### **Public Hearing and Work Session**

SB 69

Requires the Employment Department to study issues related to laws concerning job-protected leave from work.

SB 858 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Requires the Director of the Employment Department to conduct periodic assessments to determine the solvency of the Paid Family and Medical Leave Insurance Fund.

#### **Public Hearing**

SB 87

Permits the Electrical and Elevator Board to enter into agreements with municipalities to share responsibility for enforcing the Electrical Safety Law.

SB 480

Requires the Department of Consumer and Business Services to study contract terms for point of sale systems.

SB 481

Requires a license to provide earned income access services in this state.

SB 588

Provides that post-traumatic stress disorder suffered by a police officer or firefighter is an injury or disease sustained in the actual performance of duties for purposes of benefits under the Public Employees Retirement System in certain circumstances.

SB 605 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Health Care

Prohibits medical service providers from reporting the amount or existence of medical debt to a consumer reporting agency.

SB 651

Requires the Secretary of State to study methods for reducing the paperwork filing burden on businesses in this state.
