#### Work Session

SB 705

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03-25-2025 AGENDA: Provides an alternative weekly minimum amount of workers' compensation benefits for temporary total disability.

SB 906

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03-25-2025 AGENDA: Requires that itemized statements provided to employees show, in plain language, the amount and purpose of each deduction.

SB 968

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03-25-2025 AGENDA: Provides requirements for employer deductions for erroneous overpayments of wages for employees who are not subject to a collective bargaining agreement.

#### Possible Work Session

SB 1044

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03-25-2025 AGENDA: Clarifies for purposes of state wage and hour laws that "work time" does not include meal periods.

#### Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

SB 1061

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03-25-2025 AGENDA: Requires the Director of the Oregon State University Extension Service to establish a lumber grading training program.

#### Public Hearing

SB 727

Modifies the definition of "health care provider" for purposes of laws concerning job-protected leave.

SB 751 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Public Employees Retirement Board to establish definitions of "police officer" and "firefighter" for the sole purpose of determining which police officer and firefighter members of the Public Employees Retirement System are entitled to increased benefits.

## **AGENDA (cont.)**

**March 26, 2025**

SB 757

Requires the Public Employees Retirement Board to study the treatment of the salary of chaplains under the Public Employees Retirement System.

SB 831

Requires the person that has ultimate control over an insurer to file a group capital calculation with the chief insurance regulatory official of the state that the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services determines is the lead state for the insurance holding company system of which the insurer is a part.

SB 1148

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 03-25-2025 AGENDA: Prohibits disability income insurers from requiring a person to use other available benefits for which the person is eligible prior to being eligible for disability benefits offered by the insurer.

*Note change: SB 705, SB 906, SB 968, SB 1044, SB 1061, and SB 1148 have been carried over from the 03-25-2025 agenda.*

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
