HB 3178 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04-22-2025 AGENDA: Requires a seller in a motor vehicle transaction that involves a retail installment contract or lease agreement to make a good faith effort to sell the retail installment contract or lease agreement to a lender on the exact terms that the seller and buyer negotiated.

HB 3447

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 04-22-2025 AGENDA: Requires a business that makes retail sales of certain nitrous oxide canisters to verify the recipient is at least 18 years of age.

Public Hearing

HB 2128 A

Updates and standardizes state laws that govern soliciting, offering, negotiating and selling travel insurance and products and services that include or are related to travel insurance.

HB 2348

Adjusts certain economic development program statutes related to the administration of the programs.

HB 2800 A

Changes the term "worker leasing company" to "professional employer organization" in statute to reflect the use of agreements under which professional employer organizations and client employers allocate employer responsibilities for some or all of the client employer's workers.

HB 2971 A

Modifies the allowable investments for certain financial institutions.

HB 3156 A

Requires each public utility to include with each utility bill the phone numbers for the Public Utility Commission's consumer services and website address for the commission's online consumer complaint form.

Note change: HB 3178 A and HB 3447 have been added to the agenda.
