Work Session

HB 2236 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-6-2025 MEETING: Allows a worker leasing company to elect to treat the employees it furnishes to a client employer as either the employees of the company itself or of the client employer for certain purposes under unemployment insurance law.

HB 2944 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-6-2025 MEETING: Directs the Employment Relations Board to impose civil penalties against a public employer that has a history of failing to comply with certain requirements under the public employee collective bargaining act.

Public Hearing

HB 2282 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-6-2025 MEETING: Requires certain individuals to hold a retail liquor sales permit from the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission in order to sell alcohol to consumers.

HB 2680 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-6-2025 MEETING: Requires a contractor, as a condition of receiving public funds to install, repair or remodel a fenestration product or system in a public building, to have a national certification as a glazing contractor and at least one employee that has a national certification as an architectural glass and metal technician.

HB 2957 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-6-2025 MEETING: Prohibits employers from entering into agreements that shorten the statute of limitations with respect to violations over which the Bureau of Labor and Industries has enforcement authority.

Please note: HB 3167 is scheduled to hear brief testimony. The bill is scheduled for a full Public Hearing on 05-13-2025.

HB 3167 A

Prohibits willfully selling or using software that is designed to circumvent, thwart, interfere with or evade a control or measure, including a security measure or an access control system, that an

operator, ticket seller or reseller establishes or uses to ensure an equitable distribution, sale or resale of admission tickets for an entertainment event, including a public or private presale of admission tickets.

HB 3646

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-6-2025 MEETING: Adds entities in which employees of the entity own at least 50 percent of the ownership interest in the entity directly or through an employee stock ownership plan to the list of sources to which a contracting agency may give preference in procuring goods or services for public contracts.

HB 3789 A

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 5-6-2025 MEETING: Makes it unlawful to falsely impersonate a union representative.
