Work Session

SB 940

Allows development of certain accessory dwelling units, recreational vehicles or emergency shelters on farmland on which is sited certain nonfarm dwellings.

Public Hearing

SB 511 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the Department of State Lands, in consultation with the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, to develop a salmon credit pilot program to encourage the voluntary restoration of salmonid habitat in the Coquille and Coos watershed basins.

SB 504

Requires the Land Conservation and Development Commission to adopt rules by January 1, 2028, to allow soil bioengineering systems for shoreline stabilization.

SB 494

Requires the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to study classification and compensation for forestry and wildland fire positions in state government.
