**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the State Department of Agriculture, in partnership with Oregon State University, to study the potential for developing commercial seaweed production for certain purposes.

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs the State Department of Fish and Wildlife to include the relocation of beavers from western Oregon to central and eastern Oregon in a program for voluntarily relocating beavers.

SB

Instructs the forester, or a forest protective association or agency that is under contract or agreement with the State Board of Forestry for the protection of forestland against fire, and whose protection area is or may be affected by a fire on nearby federal lands, to take certain actions to address the fire.

> Allows an individual to perform equine dentistry and to verify whether cattle are pregnant without holding a valid license issued by the Oregon State Veterinary Medical Examining Board under certain circumstances.

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys to the State Department of Agriculture out of the General Fund for purposes related to the brand inspection program.

SB

Increases the maximum fee for activating a brand.
