Public Hearing

- SB 82 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Makes changes to consultations that are required for a certain grant process.
- SB 579 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Appropriates moneys to the State Fire Marshal for distribution to Central Douglas Fire and Rescue for certain purposes.
- SB 887
Instructs the Director of Agriculture to employ an organic policy special assistant to the director.

Work Session

- SB 208 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs the State Department of Agriculture, in partnership with Oregon State University, to study the potential for developing commercial seaweed production for certain purposes.
- SB 809
Clarifies that the State Department of Agriculture may inspect poultry products under the state meat inspection program.
- SB 817
Increases fees for filing a notice of intent to appeal and a motion to intervene with the Land Use Board of Appeals.

Note change: SB 845 has been removed.
