#### Public Hearing

SB 77

Describes allowable home occupations on lands zoned for forest or farm use.

SB 78

Establishes maximum size of replacement dwellings on lands zoned for forest or farm use.

SB 788

Allows lands zoned for exclusive farm use to be used for weddings or events east of the summit of the Cascade Range.
