SB 147

Requires the State Forester to study the management of the Elliott State Forest.

- SB 713 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Authorizes the issuance of lottery bonds for deposit in the Levee Project Grant Fund.
- SB 714 \*\*

Authorizes the issuance of lottery bonds to fund Columbia corridor flood safety projects in Multnomah County.

SB 733

Expands the definition of the term "potentially dangerous dog," for dog control purposes, to include a dog that inflicts serious injury on or kills livestock.

SB 1131

Directs the Oregon Department of Administrative Services to award a grant to the Chintimini Wildlife Center.

### SB 82 is scheduled solely for the purpose of consideration of the -2 amendments.

SB 82 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Makes changes to consultations that are required for a certain grant process.

#### Possible Work Session

SB 576 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Appropriates moneys from the General Fund to the State Department of Agriculture for the purpose of eradicating Japanese beetle grubs.

## AGENDA (cont.) March 20, 2025

SB 565

Requires the State Parks and Recreation Department to study existing, expanding and establishing state campgrounds within 25 miles of the Oregon coast.

SB 1076

Directs the State Department of Agriculture to impose certain fees for licenses and license renewals for animal rescue entities.
