### **Public Hearing and Possible Work Session**

SB 512 \*\* \*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means Directs the State Fish and Wildlife Commission to operate a summer steelhead fish hatchery at the Rock Creek Hatchery and release the hatchery fish into the North Umpqua River. 75

SB

Defines "high wildfire hazard area" for purposes of developing an accessory dwelling unit on lands zoned for rural residential uses or a replacement dwelling on lands zoned for resource uses.

### **Work Session**

SB 565

Requires the State Parks and Recreation Department to study existing, expanding and establishing state campgrounds within 25 miles of the Oregon coast.

SB 1189

Creates a limited exception to water quality permitting requirements for a treatment works located within the North Santiam Basin.

SB 976

Allows an individual to perform equine dentistry and to verify whether cattle are pregnant without holding a valid license issued by the Oregon State Veterinary Medical Examining Board under certain circumstances.

1019 SB

Increases the maximum fee for activating a brand.

### Note change: a possible work session for SB 75 has been added. SB 427 and SB 1153 have been removed.
