Public Hearing

- SB 83 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Makes changes related to building code standards for wildfire hazard mitigation.
- SB 85 ** **Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means
Directs the State Fire Marshal to establish a neighborhood protection cooperative grant program.

Work Session

- SB 845
Authorizes the Public Utility Commission to order the acquisition of an incumbent water utility by another water utility or entity when the incumbent water utility is not able to provide safe, adequate, efficient and reasonable service.
- SB 147
Requires the State Forester to study the management of the Elliott State Forest.
- SB 565
Requires the State Parks and Recreation Department to study existing, expanding and establishing state campgrounds within 25 miles of the Oregon coast.
- SB 976
Allows an individual to perform equine dentistry and to verify whether cattle are pregnant without holding a valid license issued by the Oregon State Veterinary Medical Examining Board under certain circumstances.

Public Hearing and Possible Work Session

- SB 74
Requires the Department of State Lands to study determinations of navigability on Oregon waterways.
